

**Description of the
Charleston Charter School for Math and Science
Chapter of the National Honor Society**

The National Honor Society extends membership packets to all 10th and 11th graders who have a GPA of 3.5 or higher after Semester 1. The membership packets are generally given out during the month of March.

The membership packets allow scholars to showcase their work in the areas of leadership, character and service. These areas, along with scholarship, make up the four pillars of the National Honor Society.

Scholars usually have a timeline of two to three weeks to compile and return the membership packet. Once that deadline has passed, the Faculty Council will review all packets and select the members who meet the ideals of the National Honor Society.

Membership is offered and the induction ceremony ordinarily occurs in early May.
